

## Consult Korean Consulate

- Indicate your visiting period and the purpose of the visit.
- Ask for eligible visa types for your visit to Korea.

## Know Your Visa Type

- **K-ETA (Korea Electronic Travel Authorization)**
  - Required for all nationals coming from visa-free countries/regions.
  - Some nationals may enter Korea with K-ETA but may be restricted for studying purposes. In this case, please apply for the C-3-1 visa below.
- **C-3-1 (Short-term General Visit)**
  - Eligible for individuals intending to visit Korea for a short period to participate in events and meetings or to obtain skills through a Korean organization.
- **D-2-8 (Short-term Study Visa)**
  - Eligible for individuals who intend to study in Korea for a certain period.
  - As D-2-8 is the most complicated visa, please consult the Consulate for C-3-1 or K-ETA before applying for this visa.

# INSURANCE

## International Students

- **International Health/Travel Insurance**
  - Must be written in English.
  - Must submit the full policy of the insurance.
  - Must cover the whole program period.
  - The beneficiary must be the student.

## Korean Nationals

- **National Health Insurance(의료보험증)**
  - Must submit the full policy of the insurance.
  - Must cover the whole program period.
  - If you haven't paid for a certain period, you need to resume the payment first.

## HISS Group Insurance

- **DB Insurance**
  - You can purchase through the link on the HISS Website.
  - Complete payment through wire transfer.
  - Group Rate: KRW 25,000~30,000

# VISA

For the HYLION program, students must consult all three consulates for the proper visa type. Please refer to the below guideline when consulting the consulate.

## Korea

- Check your eligibility for the K-ETA.
- If you are not eligible for K-ETA, check your eligibility for the **multi-entry tourist visa (C-3-9)**.
- As the program requires multiple entries to Korea, students must apply for a visa that fulfills this requirement.

02

## China

- Citizens of the 53 countries traveling to China for transit purposes are eligible for a 144-hour visa-free transit.
- Consult the Chinese Consulate to determine your eligibility, If you are not eligible, apply for a **tourist visa(L-visa)** in the country you are currently studying at.

## Japan

- Consult the Japanese consulate and check your eligibility for visa exemption to Japan.
- If you need a visa to enter Japan, apply for a **short-term stay visa** in the country you are currently studying at.
