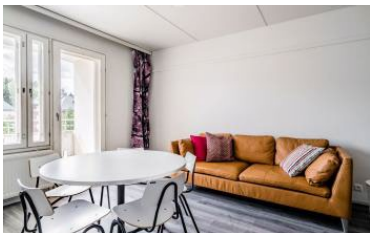

Semester dates (exam period included)	Autumn semester: 17 August 2026 - 11 December 2026 Spring semester: 18 January 2027 - 21 May 2027 https://www.haaga-helia.fi/en/academic-year Haaga-Helia organizes a compulsory 3-day on-site orientation for exchange students at the beginning of every semester. The orientation is held a week before the beginning of lessons. Sports Coaching and Management exchange studies are possible only during autumn semester or the whole academic year.
Nomination period	For autumn semester and the whole academic year: 20th March – 15th April 2026 For spring semester: 25th September – 20th October 2026 Partner universities will receive the nomination link one week before the nomination period starts.
Application period	For autumn semester and the whole academic year: 20th March – 25th April 2026 For spring semester: 25th September – 30th October 2026 Acceptance letters to accepted students will be sent within 2 weeks of the application deadline.
