Language of Instruction	• At the Universitat de Girona, most of the subjects are taught in Catalan, but some are taught in Spanish or English, and are open to exchange / mobility students. It is recommended to check the specific language requirements of each Faculty /School. • Catalan is the most spoken language at the Universitat de Girona , so the International Office organizes with the Modern Language Services an Introductory course to the Catalan language and culture before the start of each semester. The courses sare free of charge for all the exchange students and have a value of 3ECTS.
Traineeships	The mobility of students for Erasmus + for Traineeships is a modality of the Erasmus + program of the European Union. Its purpose is to help students to adapt to the demands of the European labor market, acquire specific skills and improve their understanding of the economic and social environment of the country of destination, while acquiring work experience. Learning agreement signed by your university. *Documents 1 and 2 must be uploaded when the students fill in the online application form sent to them once we receive their nomination. These documents have to be valid during all the stay. If the documents expire once they are in Girona, they have to be uploaded again with the new valid one.

In case of Traineeship mobility all our incoming students need civil liability insurance (insurance needed in case an accident happens with patients, during the placement).
