Get nominated by your university

Your International Relations Office submits your nomination between 28 Feb – 31 March via the online form.

Receive confirmation from CESA

You will get an email with your personal application link and a full document checklist.

Submit your application

Upload all required documents before
15 May 2026

4

Receive your acceptance letter

Use this to apply for a Colombian student visa if required by your nationality.

5

Arrive & attend Orientation

Orientation Week: 15–17 July. Attendance is mandatory for all incoming exchange students.

Get nominated by your university — Your International Relations Office submits your nomination between 03 – 31 March

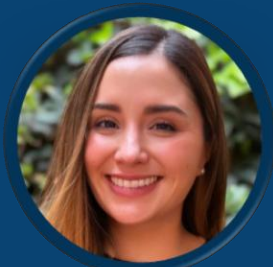
